Remember that monetary donations are always welcome. (Please make your check payable to Tennessee Baptist Children's Homes and designate "Needs Drive" in memo line)

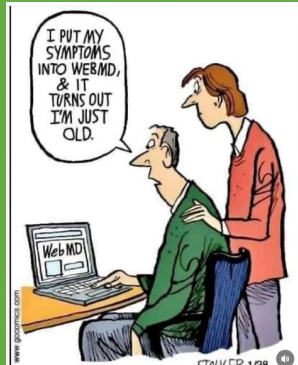
