By 2020, he joined the worship staff full time and now serves as the Associate Worship Minister. In his current role, he functions as the "Musical Director" for weekly worship services, assists Travis Cottrell with the choir, assists Mike Lawrence with the orchestra, and leads the weekly rehearsals of the student orchestra. Travis and Elizabeth are looking forward to welcoming their first child in February 2025.
