## Table Group Leader Covenant Student Ministry of Brentwood Baptist Church – FALL 2021

We believe it is a privilege to serve in this role and one should not lead with a sense of entitlement or wrongly motivated power. Every leader must be aware of their position of influence and be willing to agree and submit to the following statements:

- I commit that I believe and will lead without shame or hesitation that Jesus is the way, truth and the life (John 14:6).
- I will strive to be an example for Christ and live in such a way that my conduct does not cause anyone to stumble (Eph. 4:1).
- In being an example for Christ, my life will match up with what I do and say while serving as a Table Group Leader including all social media communications. (Romans 12:1-2).
- I will always live above reproach in the areas of relationships with other students physically, emotionally, and spiritually. (Eph. 5:3).
- I will support the total mission/vision of the student ministry. This includes praying for the ministry team and Brentwood Baptist Student Ministry overall.
- I will support and hold to the beliefs of Brentwood Baptist. This includes believing:
  - <u>The Scriptures</u> are divinely inspired, without error, and consist of the record of God's revelation of Himself to man. It has God for its author, salvation for its end, and truth for its matter. It reveals the principles by which God judges us; and therefore is, and will remain to the end of the world, the true center of Christian union, and the supreme standard by which all human conduct, creeds, and religious opinions should be tried.
  - **<u>God</u>** is the Creator and He is the one and only living and true God.
  - <u>Salvation</u> is only by grace through faith in Jesus Christ's perfect life, atoning death, and resurrection, by which declares victory over sin and death itself.
  - <u>The Church</u> is a local body of baptized believers who are associated by covenant in the faith and fellowship of the gospel, observing the two ordinances of Christ, committed to His teachings, exercising the gifts, rights, and privileges invested in them by His Word, and seeking to extend the gospel to the ends of the earth.
  - **Evangelism and Missions** is the duty and privilege of every follower of Christ and of every church of the Lord Jesus Christ to endeavor to make disciples of all nations.
  - **The Family** is the foundational institution of human society. It is composed of persons related to one another by marriage, blood, or adoption.
  - **Marriage** is the uniting of one man and one woman in covenant commitment for a lifetime.

- I will support and be a part of the mission/vision of Brentwood Baptist.
  - **The mission**: To engage the whole person with the whole gospel of Jesus Christ anywhere, anytime, with anybody.
  - <u>The vision</u>: To pursue 10,000 "disciples making disciples" relationships as a result of initiating 500,000 gospel conversations in which we will share the whole gospel of Jesus Christ with our neighbors and nations; and we will create a church multiplication movement that results in 100 healthy congregations in Middle Tennessee and beyond.

- I will faithfully attend the scheduled leadership meetings. If I miss, then I will be responsible for connecting with the Student Ministry Staff on what was covered.
- I will faithfully be a part of LIFEGroups, Sunday AM Bible studies, other Student Ministry events, and a Brentwood Baptist Church worship service.

If at any time I am unable or unwilling to fulfill this covenant in good conscience, I will relinquish my position of leadership in the student ministry at Brentwood Baptist Church.
