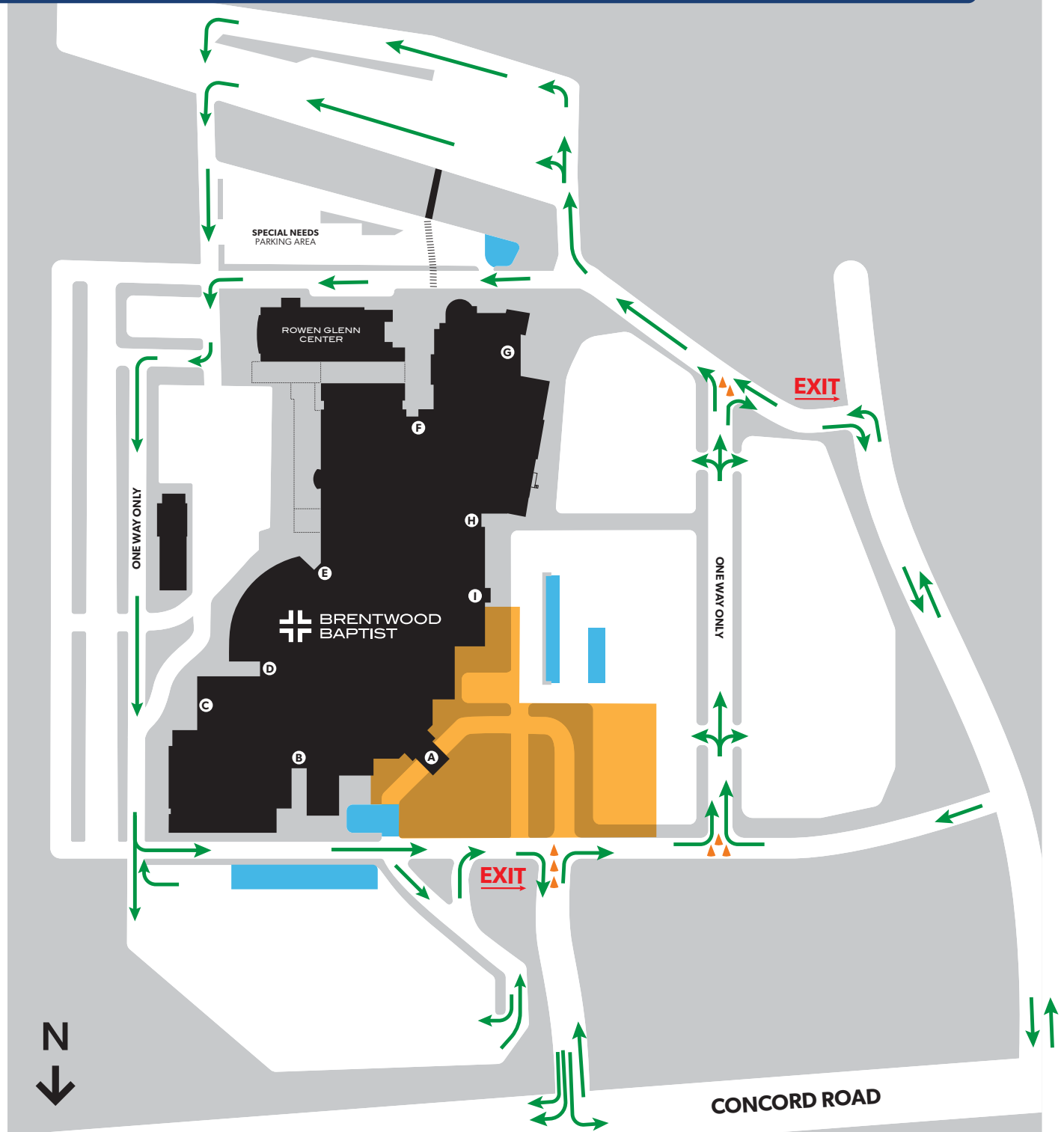

Construction Zone

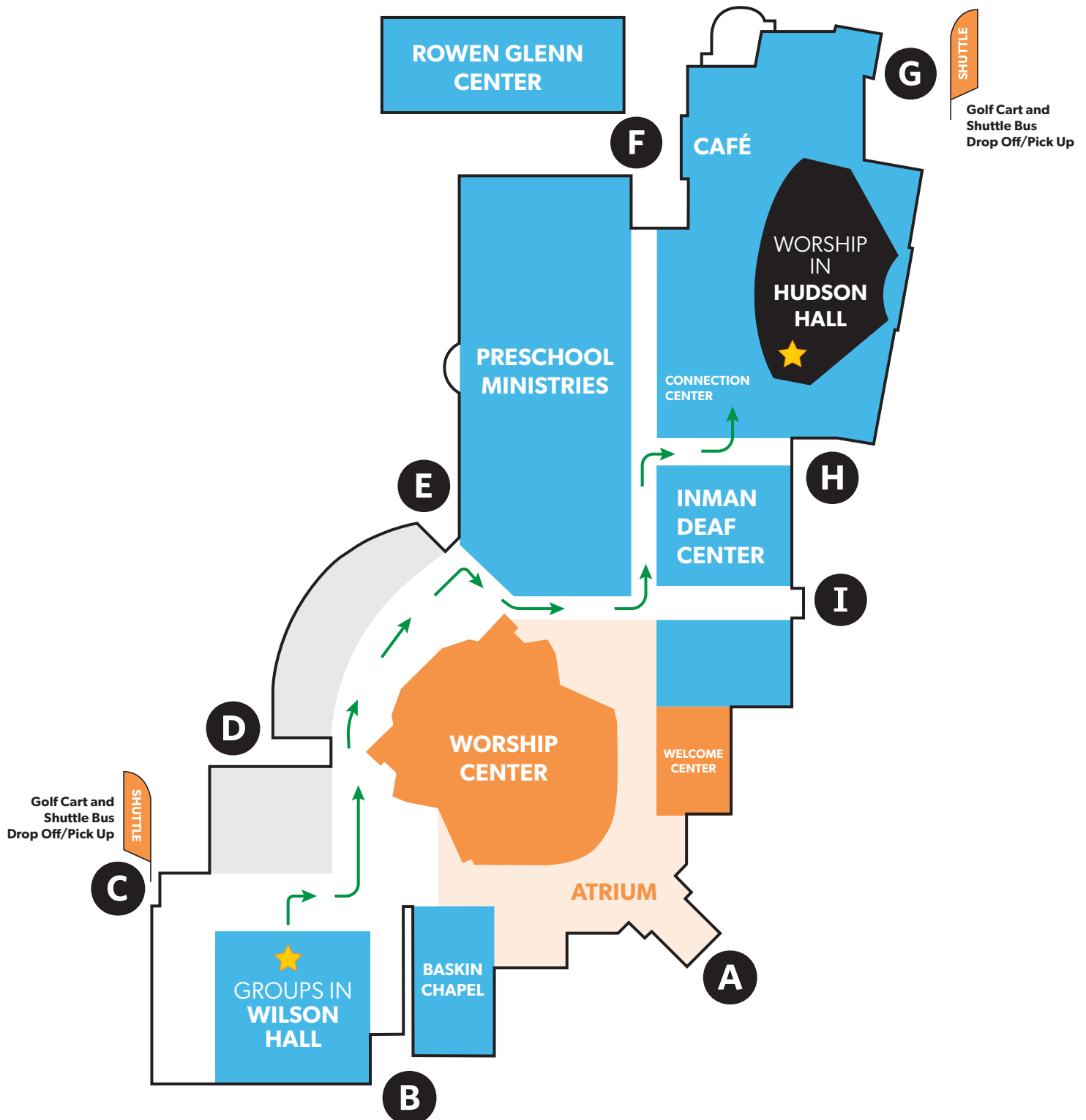
Flow of Traffic

FAQs

What is the schedule for renovations?

Thanks to your giving and pledges, Brentwood campus renovations begin Monday, May 16.

Where will we worship during renovations?

We are blessed to worship in Hudson Hall, which provides us with many of the same capabilities and ample seating capacity. The worship style will remain the same as our worship center, and we will involve many of our normal elements.

Where should I sit in Hudson Hall?

Feel free to sit where you feel most comfortable. The floor seating in Hudson Hall will be reserved for those with limited mobility and handicap.

What are the worship service times?

Currently, we are planning services at 8:00, 9:30, and 11:00 AM. We will have overflow areas/venues to accommodate. If our numbers continue to increase, we will explore other options for adding a fourth service.

Will my group need to move?

We do not anticipate moving our preschool, children, and adult groups, but their times may adjust due to the change in our worship schedule. For our students, group rooms will remain the same, but large groups will utilize the Deaf Chapel on Sundays.

My group meets in Wilson Hall, so how will I get to Hudson Hall during renovations?

We will have an alternative route that travels behind the worship center through the choir hallway. For those who have mobility issues, we will provide multiple shuttle options.

What are the options for a shuttle service?

If you are parking off-campus at the Civitan parking lot (across the interstate on Concord Road), we will have our usual shuttles available between 7:30 AM-12:30 PM. We also will have golf-carts for on-campus transportation. All shuttle services will pick up and drop off from Door G.

Where should I park on campus?

We encourage you to utilize the West parking lot outside of Hudson Hall or the South parking lot on the back of our property. We will have handicap accessible parking available. The new traffic pattern will be observed every day of the week.

Where should I enter the building?

The primary entrances for worship will be Door G (Connection Center) or Door H (between the Connection Center and Deaf Chapel).

Where do I drop off my family?

Please drop off your family at Door G. This location is also the best place to drop off those who are handicap or have limited mobility.

Do you need additional volunteers?

We're looking for volunteers to help serve in the areas of our Kids, Preschool, and Student Ministries, as well as on our Guest Services team. Your time and investment matters in the life of our church!

Do I need to RSVP for worship?

RSVPs are not needed during the renovations, but please text "SURVEY" to 623623 to let us know which worship service you plan to attend during renovations.
