PAPERWORK DROP OFF

PACKING/ GUIDELINES

WHAT TO BRING:

(Please pack light- luggage space is limited!)

- Your Bible and a pen
- Sleeping bag/ linens/ pillow
- Appropriate sleepwear
- Personal toiletries and A TOWEL

- Casual, comfortable, **WARM**, modest clothes are appropriate for the entire weekend- **it will get cold!**
- Play clothes for rec. time
- Snacks and/or money for Coke machines (not required)
- A GREAT ATTITUDE!

DRESS CODE: We have a simple dress guideline for our Fall Retreat: clean, neat, and modest.

Inappropriate clothing is an unnecessary distraction and will be addressed by our camp leadership. Here are a few other guidelines:

- Modest jeans, pants, and casual shirts
- At least one set of clothes that can get messy.
- If you have questions, don't hesitate to ask. A good general rule is: If it might be inappropriate, it probably is!

*** REMEMBER TO BRING LINENS OR A SLEEPING BAG and a TOWEL! ***

NOTE: Any student who displays inappropriate clothing or sleepwear will be politely but firmly asked to change. If a student has a continual problem with this issue, he or she may not be allowed to attend the next student retreat/camp experience.

PRESCRIPTION MEDICINE

- Fill out a Medication Form with instructions and dosages- available at registration & online.
- Put all your medications in a bag clearly labeled with your child's name.
- Turn in ALL medications at the NURSE table at registration. Please make sure to inform the nurses of any medicine that needs to be refrigerated or is taken via injection.
- Anyone NOT turning in medication will be subject to removal from the retreat. We cannot take risks in this area!

Note that we do have a retreat nurse on staff who will oversee all medications as well as injuries, illnesses, etc.

CELL PHONES will be allowed, but use will be discouraged at 6th Grade Escape.

- Cell phones can only be used during permitted times such as Free Time, Late Night, etc. **Use of phones during small groups, Bible studies and worship is *not* allowed.** If they become a distraction, they will be collected by the leader and returned at the end of the week.
- Brentwood Baptist Church and the Student Ministry are NOT responsible for the well-being of your student's phone. This includes being left at the retreat, lost or damaged in any way.

What NOT to Bring

- **THE BIG 3:** Any student who brings or participates in any of the following will be immediately sent home at their family's expense:
 - Drugs - whether legal or illegal, including tobacco, alcohol, vapes or e-cigarettes, etc.
 - Weapons - any type of weapon including knives, fireworks, firearms, etc.
 - Fighting - anyone who fights, threatens the safety of others, or fails to comply with safety rules will be subject to removal from the weekend.
- No Pranks! No water balloons, silly string, etc.

- No Animals of any kind
- No Energy Drinks.

DISPLAYS OF AFFECTION between girls and guys are inappropriate (unless married) and will not be tolerated!

ROOMS ARE PRIVATE. No Girls in Guys rooms / No Guys in Girls rooms. In addition, all dressing and changing of clothes must take place in privacy in the bathroom.

ONE: Student in bathroom and shower stalls, as well as in beds, **at all times**.

EVERYBODY INVOLVED: All students must be active participants in all scheduled programming.

LIGHTS OUT means that all rooms must turn all lights out and be quiet. Changing clothes and brushing teeth and all that pre-bed stuff must be done BEFORE Lights Out.
