Title: God Made a Covenant with David

Passage: 2 Samuel 6-7

Christ Connection:

God promised David future kings of Israel would come from David's family. God kept His promise. God sent His Son, Jesus, as part of David's family. Jesus is our King. Jesus is alive, and He will be King over God's people forever.

Questions to Discuss:

- What is one thing you remember from this week's Bible story?
- What does the covenant God made with David have to do with us now?
- What are some things you can give thanks to God for in your life?

Family Connection:

Take a drive (or do this while you're out somewhere). As you drive, point out different types of businesses. Explain how each business has a contract as they interact with employees and customers. For example: what might the contract look for members of a gym, restaurant owners and their wait staff, or a landlord and the business renting from them. Talk about the difference between contracts and covenants. Then, explain that both covenants and contracts require something from both sides. God, however, fulfills both sides of His covenant with us, because He knows we are unable to do so.

Parent Action:

Lead your family by writing down one thing you can give thanks to God for. Ask each person in your family to share around the dinner table.
