Title: The People Kept Sinning

Passage: Judges 2

Christ Connection:

After God's people sinned, the judges helped God's people obey God again. But the judges could not change the people's hearts and make them love God. God had a plan. He sent His Son, Jesus to change His people's hearts and save them from sin forever.

Questions to Discuss:

- What is one thing you remember from this week's Bible story?
- What do you need to confess that keeps you from obeying God?
- Why is it so important that God sent Jesus to save us?

Family Connection:

Set up a line of dominoes close to each other as you describe the covenant between God and His people. When you explain that God's people disobeyed, knock over the first domino. Talk about the consequences as the dominoes fall. Set them up again as you describe how God's people repented and God sent them a judge. Knock the dominoes over again when you explain that the people disobeyed again. Say the Christ Connection.

Parent Action:

God calls us to obedience, but we often choose sin. What is one area of your life where God is calling you to trust him more and give more of your heart to him?
